

There are several types of childcare in Rennes.

Childcare means having your child looked after while you are working, training or looking for work.

L'Étoile can help you choose your childcare arrangements.

Here are all the childcare options available in Rennes.







A professional who looks after your child on her own

In this case, there are 3 possible choices:

1 • A childminder (assistante maternelle) who looks after your child in her own home.

A childminder can look after a maximum of 4 children at the same time.

She is your employee.

You are her employer and she looks after your child.

You sign an employment contract with her.

You pay her a monthly salary.

2 • A childminder who looks after your child in a childcare centre.

This is a childcare centre for childminders, called a MAM (Maison d'Assistantes Maternelles).

In this case, the childminders care for your child at the centre, not in their home.

Each childminder can look after

a maximum of 4 children.

She is your employee.

You are her employer and she looks after your child.

You sign an employment contract with her.

You pay her a monthly salary.

3 • Childcare in your own home

A nanny (*garde à domicile*) looks after your child in your own home.

She can be your employee.

In this case, you become her employer.

She may also be an employee of a service company.

In this case, the company is her employer.

A professional who looks after your child in her home and in a municipal nursery

• This is a municipal childminder (assistante maternelle de l'accueil familial)

She is an employee of the City of Rennes.

The childminder can look after a maximum of 3 children.

She goes to a municipal nursery twice a week.

Your child meets other children during activities.

* To apply for a place with a municipal childminder, call l'Étoile on & 02 30 21 55 00.



Your child is looked after with other children

• In a municipal nursery (crèche municipale)

The municipal nursery is managed by the City of Rennes. It looks after between 42 and 64 children. The children are divided into small groups.

- * To apply for a place, call l'Étoile on 🎨 02 30 21 55 00.
- In a community nursery (crèche associative)

A community nursery can look after up to 60 children. Parents can help the nursery in a number of ways. For example, cleaning, computing, organising special events, etc.

• In a parent-run nursery (crèche parentale)

A parent-run nursery can look after a maximum of 25 children.

The parents become members of the association.

They help the professionals with various tasks:

- → Childcare and activities
- → Shopping, cleaning, gardening, etc.

To apply for a place, call the parent-run nurseries directly.

• In a micro-nursery (micro-crèche)

A micro-nursery can look after a maximum of 12 children.

To apply for a place, call the micro-nurseries directly.

• In a company nursery

If you work, your employer may have places in a company nursery.

You can ask them.

• In an occasional nursery (halte-garderie)

This type of nursery looks after children for shorter periods, in the morning or afternoon, 1, 2 or 3 times a week.

To apply for a place, call the nurseries directly.

How do you apply for a place for your child in a municipal or community nursery?

- Call l'Étoile on @ 02 30 21 55 00.
- Make an appointment.
- On the day of the appointment, bring:
 - → Your ID and that of the other parent if you are a couple
 - → Proof of address such as an electricity, water or telephone bill,
 - → Proof of household income (attestation de quotient familial) from the Caf [social security benefits office] or MSA [social security for employees in the agricultural sector]
 - → Depending on your situation, your payslip or training certificate or certificate from the employment office [Pôle emploi] or declaration from the URSSAF [the organisation that collects social security contributions from business owners]
- L'Étoile will register your application for a place.



Your application will be examined when a place becomes available.

- If you are offered a place and accept it:
 - → The nursery manager will call you
 - → She will give you an appointment
 - → At the appointment, you sign a childcare contract with the nursery
- If you are not offered a place:
 - → L'Étoile keeps your application
 - → L'Étoile will email you in June and December to ask if you still require childcare

You must inform l'Étoile if your family or work situation changes.
